Safer Internet Day

As a school, we will be participating in 'Safer Internet Day', which takes place on Tuesday 7th February. We emphasise safety constantly when using the internet, however taking part in the national 'Safer Internet Day' gives us the opportunity to highlight this issue even more. The theme for this year is 'Be the change: unite for a better internet' and classes throughout the school will be carefully considering how to be safe online through activities and discussion linked to this theme. The day offers the opportunity to highlight positive uses of technology and to explore the role we all play in helping to create a better and safer online community. It calls upon young people, parents, carers, teachers, social workers, law enforcement, companies, policymakers, and wider, to join together in helping to create a better internet. On Friday 10th February each class will present one area of their learning about Safer Internet Day in our Celebration Assembly at 9am. We would love to see as many of you at this assembly as possible.
