#### **Attendance**

As per our attendance policy, we will be publishing attendance and punctuality figures each week in the newsletter now for each class as well as for the whole school. Each class will use a traffic light system for attendance where green is for 100% - 98%, yellow for 98% - 96% and red for less than 96%.

We really appreciate the support we are receiving from many parents in ensuring their child is attending school regularly. We have also seen a decrease in children arriving late to school which is fantastic. We would just like to remind you of the following;

We are not allowed to authorise requests for children to be taken out of school for a holiday during term time. We are only able to authorise other absences if there are exceptional circumstances.

- GP and dental appointments should be made out of school hours unless it is an emergency.
- Hospital appointments should be arranged for out of school hours or for the afternoons where possible.
- Where hospital appointments are given (e.g. for certain clinics which only run at given times)
  parents should request an appointment that will enable their child to be in school for as much of
  the day as possible. All children should be in school for the first part of the morning wherever
  possible.

Private or alternative health care appointments will not be allowed (authorised) in school hours unless supported by a GP letter and evidence that the practitioner only provides services in school hours. In the morning all children should arrive in the school playground by 8.42am, for when the bell rings so that children are actually in the building at 8.45am. If a child arrives after the playground door has been locked and enters school through the main entrance, they will be marked down as late.

We really appreciate your support in helping your child to maximise their learning experience, helping them to reach their full potential.

#### **Football Match**

On Monday the football team played a match against Seaford Primary. Many thanks to Mr Gratwick our team coach who organised this match and accompanied the team. He reports that we conceded 2 early goals and then we played fantastically, winning 3-2, but it could quite easily have been 5 or 6!
