## Attendance

# **Celebration Assembly Cancelled & Christmas Tree Decorating Assembly**

Unfortunately we won't be able to hold our usual celebration assembly tomorrow, 1<sup>st</sup> December. This is because new windows are currently being fitted in Emerald Class so the hall is being used as their classroom. We will return to having celebration assembly with Stars of the Week, certificates, birthdays, etc, the following week, 8<sup>th</sup> December, at 9am when we will also be decorating the school Christmas tree. We hope that the children are busy making Christmas tree decorations ready to bring in to school for this. We invite children to bring in decorations which they have made at home that they would like to decorate the school tree with. By the end of the assembly our bare Christmas tree is transformed into a beautifully dressed tree!

#### School Christmas Lunch – Deadline

We will be having our school Christmas lunch on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> December. As is our long tradition, we would like as many children as possible to have the cooked school meal on this day so that we can all enjoy the occasion together. The children will be served roast turkey, cocktail sausage wrapped in bacon, sage and onion stuffing, roast potatoes, peas and carrots topped off with gravy. Alternatively the vegetarian option of Quorn roast is available. The main meal will be followed by a Christmas shortbread biscuit and fresh fruit. The children are invited to bring in Christmas hats to wear during lunch. Parents of children who already have school meals on a Thursday will have the Christmas lunch included on their normal termly bill, if in Sapphire or Emerald Classes. For those who normally have a packed lunch, please send in the reply slip at the end of the newsletter along with payment of £2.10, in a clearly marked envelope, by tomorrow, Friday 1<sup>st</sup> December. All children in Pearl and Ruby Classes can have the lunch free of charge under the universal infant free school meal scheme. Please note that we will require a reply slip for <u>every</u> child, whether they normally have a school lunch or not, recording their meal choice so that Alison, our cook, knows quantities to order.

#### **Christmas Decorations Day**

On Monday, 4<sup>th</sup> December, the children will be taking part in our annual Christmas decorations day. Throughout the day they will be in mixed year groups making all sorts of decorations so that by the end of the day we will have a wonderful collection of decorations to hang up around the school to make us look very festive!
