



Primary School Sport Premium Report Background

The current government has made a commitment to provide schools with specific funding to help improve the provision of PE and Sport within the primary setting. This was initially for academic years 2013-2014 to 2015-2016 but has been recently extended into the next parliament to 2020. The aim of the funding is to improve the quality of Sport and PE in every primary school and obtain long term sustainability. Over £4 million has been allocated of primary schools in Sussex and around £1.5 million allocated to schools in East Sussex.

The Department of Education announced that for 2017 – 2018, the PE & Sports Grant will be doubled per school.
