Fence

As you are aware the children's safety is always of upmost importance to us. Our boundary fence has been there since the school opened and its height no longer meets the minimum height requirements so we will be replacing parts of the current fence before Christmas. We are lucky to have a fair amount of foliage around the boundary; this will remain and the fence replaced where it is open. As well as a new fence we will also be having a new entry gate which will be at the perimeter; this will prevent any unauthorised access to the playground and Early Years/KS1 outdoor area.
