Welcome Back

Important Reminders

- All children should have a book bag, every day these are used every day in class. If your child needs a book bag these are available to purchase from the school office.
 - Can children only bring a rucksack to school if absolutely necessary. We are seeing an increased number of rucksacks and due to limited space on the pegs it can be difficult for these to fit.

Children with pierced ears must remove any earrings before their PE and games lessons. They need to be able to do this themselves or they need to be removed at home prior to school. If the child is unable to remove earrings then they must be securely covered with surgical tape before children arrive at school (with the exception of swimming, when we do not allow any jewellery to be worn).

Children need a water bottle, with a sports lid, in school every day. It is important for children to keep hydrated, water bottles are available for children to use in class throughout the day.

Please ensure children arrive on time every day. We are seeing an increased number of lates. This is disruptive to a child's learning which starts on arrival at school. Children in Pearl and Ruby Class should arrive at 8.40am children in Sapphire and Emerald Class should arrive at 8.45am.

WW2 Learning - Emerald Class

On Wednesday 4th January 2023, Emerald Class were transported back in time as World War 2 evacuees for a day like no other! They experienced air raid drills, were checked for identification throughout the day and role-played what it would be like to leave the city for a new and unfamiliar life in the countryside. The day

brought the curriculum to life for the children who learnt all about why WW2 started and who was involved as well as preparing to debate whether evacuation was a good idea or not. It was also very interesting to read our own school's log

book from the 1939 – 1945 to learn about what life was like here in our school during

WW2. The class found out that 120 children were evacuated from London, joining the 65 children on roll in Alfriston and almost tripling the number of children in the school! They heard about air raid warnings that took place day after day and discovered the history behind the famous sea mine on display at the Tye.
