Pearl Class

In Pearl class this week, they have been learning about sea creatures! They have watched film clips and read information books about sea creatures and then written their own facts about their favourite sea creatures!

They have also been practising naming and describing 2 dimensional and 3 dimensional shapes. To help them, they made shape sea creatures and named the shapes they used. The class have also been practising counting in 2's, reading and spelling tricky words and practising for School Games Day next week.

They have spent some 'transition' time with the Year 1 children to continue to get to know them before they move on to join them in Ruby class!

Ruby Class

In Ruby class this week, the children finally re-potted their sunflowers and took them home. They also looked carefully at the other seeds in the investigation and found out what plants need to grow happy and healthy.

In maths, they have been exploring symmetry and position and direction.

The children are still enjoying working on their holiday brochures. Thank you for sending in lots of examples - the children loved looking through them to gain inspiration.

Sapphire Class

In Sapphire, they have been exploring statistics and have used their maths lessons to represent and interpret data using bar charts, pictograms and tables.

In English, they have been looking at standard and non-standard English so that they can make sure they use standard English in our writing.

The children also recreated Tudor symbols in their art lessons using tone and shading.

Emerald Class

Emerald Class have been writing letters to their French penfriends this week, using short phrases that they have learned and dictionaries to check vocabulary and spellings. They have also continued their work about living things and habitats, looking at how non-flowering plants reproduce - they did some research and wrote about their findings as well as drawing pictures to illustrate their work.
