### **House Lego Competition**

#### **Lego Competition A: The tallest tower**

- To be held in the school hall on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> March at our 10am assembly.
- House teams of 7 pupils (1 per year group).
- To enter this competition, please complete and return the slip below to be entered into a draw.
- The lego used will be provided by the school, please do not bring any in.
- The teams will be given a time limit of 4 minutes.
- The house team that ends up with the tallest tower is the winner.

# **Lego Competition B: The best sculpture**

- Lego or duplo may be used to create your sculpture.
- We are looking for a creative, detailed and a well-designed, put together structure.
- This is an individual competition no pairs or groups may enter.
- The pupil creating the sculpture must be able to carry it safely into school by themselves (ie. No oversized or heavy sculptures, please)
- Please supply a label with your sculpture with your name, year group (not class name) and house.
- Any pupil at Alfriston School can enter.
- You can only enter one sculpture per pupil.
- The sculptures will be judged (out of 10) by any visitor who comes to the school during the week beginning Monday 16<sup>th</sup> March (we have at least 6 visitors already planned to come in during this week).
- Lego sculptures to be brought in to the school hall on the morning of Monday 16th March. If your sculpture is brought in later than this then you have the risk of a

visitor not seeing it and so your score could potentially be lower than the other entries.

# Lego Competition C: The relay obstacle course

- To be held in the playground.
- Each class will arrange for this competition to happen in their own time during the week.
- The class will be split into their house teams, each with the same relay obstacle course to complete. The team will collect a piece of lego at one end of the obstacle course to bring back and place on the weighing scales. The House with the heaviest amount of lego wins.
