Pearl Class

This week has been a very sporty week! The children have practised and taken part in their first School Games Day. Well done, Pearl Class for being very determined to do your best!

The class have also been reading the story, 'Sharing a Shell' by Julia Donaldson and writing about their favourite part. They have been learning how to share objects in maths too! They created sea creature prints by drawing onto polystyrene tiles and used printing ink to print their drawings. They look amazing! They have also been continuing to practise reading and spelling words with four sounds during phonics. What a busy week!
