### **Home Learning information**

It has now been two weeks of remote learning and we have been totally bowled over by how well the children (and parents/carers) have adapted to Google Classroom! Although we were planning on moving over to Google Classroom this term, it came a little sooner than anticipated and everyone has done so well with the change.

With our remote learning we aim to ensure that teaching and learning continue as effectively as possible in the light of school closure. We are aiming to continue to ensure high educational standards during this time, in line with our school vision. We are committed to learning as a partnership between children, teachers and parents/carers.

#### We have an expectation that, during term time, work will be:

- Set daily outlined on a weekly timetable;
- Set up via pre-recorded teaching sessions on Google Classroom;
  - Appropriate to year group needs;
    - Completed by all children.

#### How can parents/carers help?

- Ensure your child can access relevant websites, if they forget their passwords please contact the office.
  - Check Google Classroom and discuss what work has been set with your child.
  - Talk with your child about their work and the importance of completing the work set.
    - Help your child to manage their time.
    - Praise your child for successful completion of the work.
  - Email the class email account if there are queries about the work or further help is required staff are available between 8:45 and 3:00 each school day.
    - Playstations, Xboxes and Nintendo Switches can be used to access learning via Google.
