### Pearl Class

This week in Pearl Class, the children have been reading and retelling 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. They have practised using a story voice and great story words when telling the story with their friends. They have been playing with porridge to learn about capacity! They have learnt the words, 'full', 'empty', 'nearly full', 'nearly empty' and 'half full' to describe how much is in a bowl. The children also compared the capacity of two bowls, finding out which one was the best for Daddy Bear!

### **Ruby Class**

This week Ruby Class were reporters! They have been learning all about newspapers in preparation for writing their own article. In maths, they have been learning about multiplication. They have been learning to recognise equal groups and beginning to record their calculations. In art and design, the children made their 'underpants' using a simple running stitch. They also carefully cut out patterns from felt to add detail to their designs. The children are looking forward to writing their newspaper reports next week!

### Sapphire Class

In Sapphire Class this week the children have been showing their creative flair by studying poetry structure and writing poems about their favourite Greek Gods and Goddesses. Their creative and descriptive language has been outstanding. They will showcase these poems outside the classroom and also plan to make a class poetry book. In maths the children have tackled division with remainders using a variety of different methods. They have also been continuing to practice their times tables and are really making great progress.

## **Emerald Class**

Emerald Class have been quite split through their mornings this week, with Year 6 doing an amazing job on some practice SATs papers! Year 5 have worked hard in the classroom, learning about proportion and scale factors, as well as decimal numbers in maths and practising punctuating in English. The class have learned about the Ancient Greek myth 'Theseus and the Minotaur' and began to compose dance sequences based on the events.
