This Week's Class News

Pearl Class

In Pearl class this week, they have been learning about night time animals and have sorted pictures of day and night time animals. They have enjoyed the stories 'Owl Babies' and 'The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark' and have written character speech bubbles. They have learnt about dark and light colours and have enjoyed colour mixing to create dark colours. They made an amazing mixed media picture of Plop, the baby owl, from the story, 'The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark'. They have also enjoyed creating owl pictures using soft pastels! They have learnt all about number 9 and now know that $3+3+3=9$! The class continued to rehearse their Christmas play with Ruby class and are really looking forward to showing you all next week!

Ruby Class

The children in Ruby Class loved starting their week with 'decoration day'. They showed excellent collaboration and created some wonderful pieces to decorate the school. In English, the children wrote a diary entry in role as Thomas Farriner and explored how he might have been feeling on the day of the fire. In DT, the children designed and began creating their Tudor style houses (thank you for all the cereal boxes!). The children have been working very hard during their Christmas play rehearsals and are doing very well!

Sapphire

In Sapphire Class this week, they have been continuing to learn about the way that paragraphs can support them when they are organising their ideas in writing. They have also been looking at word problems in maths and thinking about ways to approach them. The class have set up a Science investigation into tooth decay, using eggs and a variety of liquids. They talked about how we can control the variables in order to make it a fair test. We will let you know what we find out!

Emerald Class

Emerald Class have been learning about different kinds of numbers that appear in the world of maths, such as square and cube numbers, and prime factors. In English, the class have been exploring different texts that are written to discuss and persuade ready to write a letter to the Victorian villain Mack the Knife. The final Forest School session took place this week. It was a fantastic afternoon of whittling, sawing, drilling, crafting and fire lighting.
