

## School Council Meeting

### 1) Our School Charter & Life Values

We reminded ourselves of our School Charter and the display in the school hall that the reps helped to create, and then discussed how well we thought the school was doing with this. The reps gave examples of when they have seen or heard their peers adhering to our School Charter and showing a positive impact. The reps were able to explain how some children needed individual support in order to be at their best. The reps said that they were aware of some children who found this more difficult and that they hadn't yet managed to be at their best consistently.

We talked about how the Life Values we have at our school also help us to be at our best and the reps shared examples of these when they are learning but also when they are in the playground, around the school or out and about in the community. We drew out the important words and phrases of how our Life Values are linked with our curriculum and everything that we do at school.

### 2) Our 'Hopes & Dreams'

Mrs Hudson asked the reps to think about our School Charter and our Life Values. The reps gave some examples as to how developing these were not only helping them in school now but also how they will help for the future (eg. when at secondary school, when they meet other people, when they are finding a job). The reps thought about what their hopes and dreams were for the future, knowing that these pro-learning and pro-social skills and behaviours are helping them with these. Each rep willingly shared their hopes/dreams, and Mrs Hudson also shared hers. It was decided that it would be nice to display these (the reps would think about the best way) and to encourage others to do the same. We decided to meet again soon to do this as we ran out of time.
