Mathematics

Year 1

Measurement

- I can compare, describe, measure, record and solve practical problems for:
- i. lengths and heights
- ii. mass / weight
- iii. capacity and volume
- iv. time (hours, minutes, seconds)
- I can sequence events in chronological order using language
- I can recognise and use language relating to dates, including days of the week, weeks, months and years
- I can tell the time to the hour and half past the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.

Fractions

- I can recognise, find and name a half as 1 of 2 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity
- I can recognise, find and name a quarter as 1 of 4 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

Year 2

<u>Measurement</u>

- I can choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction (m/cm); mass (kg/g); temperature (°C); capacity (litres/ml) to the nearest appropriate unit, using rulers, scales, thermometers and measuring vessels
- I can compare and order lengths, mass, volume/capacity and record the results using >,
 < and =
- I can solve simple problems in a practical context involving addition and subtraction of money of the same unit, including giving change
- I can compare and sequence intervals of time
- I can tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.
- I can know the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day $\underline{\mbox{Fractions}}$
- I can recognise, find, name and write fractions 1/3, 1/4, 2/4 and 3/4 of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity $% \left(\frac{1}{2}\right) =0$
- I can write simple fractions, for example 1/2 of 6 = 3 and recognise the equivalence of 2/4 and 1/2.
