Learning Intentions:

CHANGES

I can tell you how change makes me feel.

When I feel bad, I know that it helps to do something different.

I know that sometimes when people are not nice to me it is because they don't feel good inside.

I know how to help someone when they are feeling sad.

I can tell you what I did with my class to make the setting even better.

Learning experiences:

- Circle time, stories, games, puppet play

Maths

Learning Intentions:

I can add and subtract two single digits together by counting on or back.

I can double, halve and share amounts of objects.

I can estimate amounts.

I can count in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's.

I can name and describe 2D and 3D shapes.

I can use the language of measure, position, direction, time and money.

Learning experiences:

- Problem solving in context! Addition, subtraction, doubling, halving and sharing
- Estimating the number of objects and counting in jumps of 2, 5 and 10
- Shape and pattern – linked to sea creatures
- Pirate treasure – capacity and money
- Pirate adventures and map making – position and direction

Communication and Language

Learning Intentions:

I can express my own ideas about events or characters in the story and answer questions about why things happened.

I can develop my own narratives by connecting ideas and events. I can use a range of vocabulary.

I can listen to and follow instructions that involve several ideas.

Learning experiences:

- Explaining own thoughts and ideas about different stories during individual and group reading sessions
- Tell or act out own version of pirate and seaside stories
- Explain clearly how you made something
- Follow instructions with independence during adult tasks

Literacy: Reading and Writing

Learning Intentions:

I can blend and segment sounds in 4 and 5 sound words — frog, clap, sleep.

I can read a range of tricky words.

I can read and understand sentences.

I can write sentences or stories including finger spaces and full stops.

Learning experiences:

- Developing writing skills through guided activities linked to core texts and activities – writing own seaside and pirate adventure stories; an information book about sea creatures and sea creature poems.
- Regular phonic sessions
- Individual and group reading at school

Learning Intentions:
