## Number and place value

Year 3

- •I can count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100;
- •I can find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number;
- •I can recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number (hundreds, tens, ones);
- •I can solve number problems and practical problems involving these ideas.

Year 4

- I can count in multiples of 6, 7, 9, 25 and 1000;
- I can count backwards through zero to include negative numbers;
- I can order and compare numbers beyond 1000;
- I can round any number to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000; Addition and subtraction
- •I can add and subtract numbers mentally;
- •I can add and subtract numbers using formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction;
- •I can solve addition and subtraction problems in context, deciding which operations and methods to use and why.

### Science

### Animals including humans

- I can identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat.
- I can describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans.
- I can construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.



English

- I can listen to and discuss a wide range of texts;
- I can discuss words and phrases that capture the reader's interest and imagination;
- I can ask questions to improve my understanding of a text;
- I can compose and rehearse sentences orally, building a varied and rich vocabulary and an increasing range of sentence structures;
- In narratives, I can create settings, characters and plot.

# Geography

- I can ask and answer geographical questions about the physical and human characteristics of a location.
- I can use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features.
- I can name and locate the Equator, Northern Hemisphere, Southern Hemisphere, the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn and the Arctic and Antarctic Circle.
- I can describe geographical similarities and differences between countries.
- I can use the eight points of a compass.
