This Week's Class News

Pearl Class

This week, Pearl class have been learning about real bears! They researched facts about grizzly bears, polar bears and panda bears using information books. They wrote their own information book including their favourite facts. They made bear masks using paint and collage materials. They learnt to count back when subtracting and used some polar bears to help them practise this new skill! In their PE sessions they enjoyed dancing to the music, 'The Bear Necessities' and practising stretching and curling movements in gymnastics. Lastly, they had lots of fun during 'World Book Day', making their own 'Brown Bear, brown Bear' books and reading with Emerald class.

Ruby Class

In Ruby Class this week, the children received a special message from Bob's wife (Bob, The Man On The Moon). The message asked if they could write a set of instructions for someone to follow so that Bob can take a holiday with his wife. The children have written some excellent instructions! In computing the children used their new logins and learnt how to turn the laptops on and off. During DT, they explored where food comes from and sorted food into different groups. In art and design, the children designed a pair of underpants (for an alien) which they will then make out of felt in the upcoming weeks. The children had a great time celebrating 'World Book Day' on Thursday and loved the House Competition.

Sapphire Class

In Sapphire Class this week, in their English lessons, the children have continued their work on the Greek Gods and Goddesses. They have worked on persuasive writing and writing with strong descriptive phrases. In Maths the children have been continuing to learn methods to divide 2 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers and can now exchange between the tens and ones when required. They are also continuing to learn their times tables - this week the 4 times table. In Design and Technology, the children have constructed their multi surface race tracks and they look forward to testing the magnetic cars on them next week!

Emerald Class

The maths focus in Emerald Class this week has been ratio and proportion. This introduction to ratio has included learning the correct mathematical language and linking fraction knowledge. English lessons have been spent exploring film trailers and film techniques. The class then created their own trailers for their chosen World Book Day book. In geography, the learning has been focused on renewable energy sources and the class constructed and tested their own hydro turbines. Tuesday afternoon we had fun designing and constructing Ancient Greek items and artefacts!
