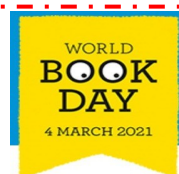

COVID Update - Household Testing

In the letter from the local authority last week, it explained that households with primary and secondary age children can access testing kits for the rest of the family. These test kits are not issued by school. You can get a home testing kit:

- By searching online for your nearest COVID19 Test Site. Most collection points are open between 1.30pm - 7pm. You do not need to make an appointment.
- Alternatively there is a new home ordering service available online or by calling 119 (you should not order online if you can get a test through other methods. This frees up home delivery for those who need it most).
