

School Attendance

Now that things are more like they were pre Covid, we wanted to remind you of the expectations with regards to attendance.

Children should be at school, <u>on time, every day</u>. Arriving late at school can be very disruptive and very unsettling for the late child, the teacher and other children in the class. Please note that if children are consistently late a fine can be issued.

Please remember that holidays or days out must not be taken during term time. It is compulsory and parents' legal duty that children of school age attend school full time. Holidays should, therefore, **not** be taken in term time - fines are issued for holidays taken in term time.

If we suspect a child has been absent from school due to a holiday that we have not been informed about, the absence will be unauthorised and it is the responsibility of the parent(s) to provide evidence to the contrary, ie. a doctor's certificate. Without the evidence, a fine will be issued.

There are strong links between good attendance at school and children's academic progress and success. All staff and Governors of our school want the children to fulfil their potential – children need to attend school for this to happen. Thank you for your support.
